California County Supervisors to Convene for 127th Annual Meeting in Monterey

SACRAMENTO – The California State Association of Counties (CSAC), the voice of California’s 58 Counties at the state and federal levels, announces its 127th Annual Meeting titled *Lighthouse of Leadership*. The meeting will take place in person from November 29 to December 3, 2021, in Monterey, California.
