INDIGENOUS PEOPLE GRANT PROGRAM

The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) is announcing the release of the Missing and Murdered Indigenous People Grant Program, Request for Proposals (RFP). This RFP makes \$11,400,000 available competitively to federally recognized Indian tribes in California to support efforts to identify, collect case level data, publicize, and investigate and solve cases involving missing and murdered indigenous people.

Proposals must be received through the BSCC-Submittable Application portal by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 23, 2023. Additional information regarding the BSCC-Submittable Application portal, Proposal Instruction Packet, and required documents are available on the Missing and Murdered Indigenous People Grant Program webpage.

A virtual Bidder's Conference will be held via Zoom on May 12, 2023 at 10:00 A.M. A link to the Bidders' Conference is provided within the RFP and will be posted on the BSCC website.
