### SYSTEMIC APPROACH IS CRITICAL

criminal justice system must operate as a system strong/broad collaboration/communication data-driven processes to restructure local system data-driven system "diagnosis" & decision-making

cost benefit of various interventions
utilizing county data to measure investments
working with CSAC to identify counties
2 to 3 counties; committed to expand to others




