- Broadband, cybersecurity, and telecommunications
- Childcare
- Economic development: Financing tools, eminent domain, job training programs
- Elections: Administration and funding
- General Government: County governance, Brown Act, Public Records Act, privacy/identity theft issues
- General Services: Americans with Disabilities Act, prevailing wage, labor compliance, service contracts
- Governance: Boards of Supervisors' authority and duties, LAFCO
- Local revenue: Vehicle license fees, bonded indebtedness, investments, constitutional protections, fees, reorganization, incorporation, local finance
- Mandates: Claiming process, reimbursement, constitutional protections
- Personnel Management: Labor relations/collective bargaining, wages (terms and conditions), personnel records/programs/practices, employee training and development, Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA), California Family Rights Act (CFRA), Pregnancy Disability Leave (PDL)
- Political Reform Act and conflict of interest code
- Public Retirement: 1937 County Employees Retirement Act law, Public Employees' Retirement Law, Public Employees Medical and Hospital Care Act (PEMHCA) law
- Risk Management: Unemployment insurance, State Disability Insurance (SDI), health and dental insurance, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), other insurance
- State finance: State budget, school finance, general obligation bonds
- Taxation: Property tax, sales and use tax, other state and local taxes, administration, constitutional protections
